Dear Commissioner Rose:

I write on behalf of the Forest Society's Board of Trustees to share our concerns about the draft decision you announced April 16, 2015 regarding the proposed ski expansion at Mount Sunapee State Park. We appreciate having the opportunity to provide additional feedback to our comments delivered at the May 5 hearing.

The Society for the Protection of New Hampshire Forests asks you to pay particular attention to the impacts that ski area expansion would have on the forest resource at Mount Sunapee. In January of this year DRED's Natural Heritage Bureau released an addendum to its initial ecological survey of Mount Sunapee's West Bowl forests which identified (for the first time) that the summit and slopes of Mount Sunapee host a 484 acre "exemplary natural community system" of two forest communities. This exemplary system includes land directly in the project area of the proposed expansion, which would be disturbed if the project were to move forward as proposed. The viability of this exemplary natural community is of particular concern to the Forest Society, and we urge you to ensure that any final decision on the proposed expansion is consistent with the laws that protect that resource.
